What to bring:

- Sleeping bag, pillow, sheets, air mattress, etc. (things you need to sleep)
- Clothes for 7 days and 6 nights - you may want to bring older clothes for worksites; please include at least one pair of jeans. Remember, dress modestly. We are here in service to our Lord.
- Tennis shoes for worksites (mandatory)
- One pair of work gloves
- Towels, washcloths, etc., for showering; towels for swimming
- Please bring a **MODEST** swim suit and t-shirt for swimming
- Suntan lotion and mosquito repellent
- Bibles, journals, rosaries, etc. (items for prayer/reflection)
- Snacks (that you can share with everyone)
- Spending money: On Friday we will travel to Blue Bayou Water Park in Baton Rouge. You will need money to eat lunch, for souvenirs, etc. NOTE: Your admission to the park is paid by RISE.
- And your heart, so that God can heal you, transform you, and show you how much you are loved by Him!!!!

PLEASE NOTE: RISE will end with a closing Mass on Saturday, July 24, at 10:30 a.m. at Camp Woodman. **Families and friends are invited to join us.** RISE will dismiss immediately following the Mass.

Directions to Camp Woodman, Abbeville

Go south on Hwy. 167 (Johnston Street) to Abbeville. Pass the intersection at Hwy. 14 in Abbeville (Ray Chevrolet will be on your right). Continue straight ahead; pass Vermilion Catholic High School. Go to the end of the road. Take a left, then an immediate right on Old South Henry Road (Hwy. 335) – you will see a sign for Richard's Patio. Continue on this road and pass Richard's Patio on your right. Continue and pass over a small bridge. You will see a sign that says HWY 335. Veer left on 335. Go about 100 yards, then turn right on Junius Road. Follow the road to the camp by turning left once and then right. The camp is about 1 mile on your left from your last turn.
